The Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the City's draft General Plan is now available for public review and comment. This document analyzes the environmental impacts of the General Plan and, once certified, will become the primary environmental document to evaluate future development in the City.

Amador Disposal has notified their customers of this change, and announced that they will continue to manage the Transfer Station off of Buena Vista Road. Containers and bins will be picked up from customers in Lone on their final service day, Friday, July 31, 2009.

ACES, an Amador County solid waste provider will continue to work with the City to ensure that all residents who desire solid waste removal from their property are able to do so. ACES offers three size garbage waste containers, (32, 64 and 96 gallon), and separate yard clipping and recycle containers. Garbage is picked up each week, recycle and yard waste on alternate weeks. All three are included in the service price. At this time, pick up in Lone is scheduled for Wednesday, but is subject to change based on the volume of customers.
